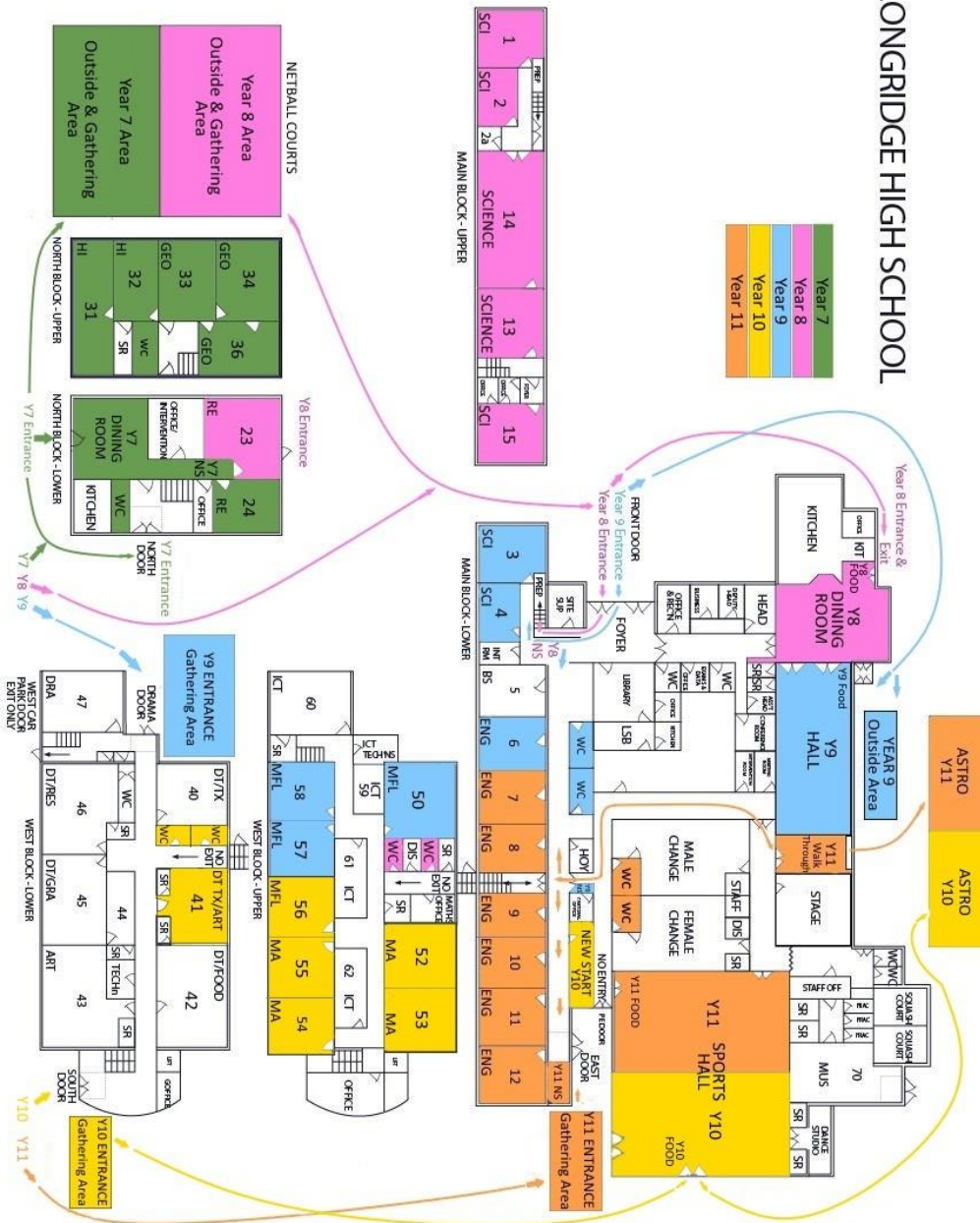

Arrival at school 8.30-8.40am

Induction Day – Thursday 3rd September 2020

Important Information

Due to Covid 19 restrictions, we have had to change the way that school works from September. We have put each year group into a different zone for their lessons. You will be taught in an area of specific classrooms for: English, Geography, History, Maths, RE and Science and your teachers will come to you so that you can follow a full timetable of subjects.

Year 10 Yellow Zone

As a year group, you will be based in the West Block (Rooms 41, 52, 53, 54, 55 and 56.) for all your lessons (except Systems, Timbers, Food and Nutrition, iMedia, Computing, Enterprise and Marketing, Health and Social Care, Music, Art, Drama and PE. You will be taught in specialist subject suites for these lessons). You will have your breaks and lunches in the Sports Hall and the Astro area and you will **only** use the toilets in Lower West Block. Your outside space is on the Astro area.

You must not enter other zones in school unless it is for one of your timetabled specialist subjects. (See map for Year 10 Yellow Zone)

In class

- Make sure you always sit in your allocated seat.
- Keep your exercise books and equipment in your teaching base. (Don't take them home)
- Keep all your exercise books/whiteboard/reading book in the zip folder provided and make sure it is tidy.
- Organise all your marked work in your Folder of Excellence under the correct subject heading.
- Bring your writing equipment/homework/pupil planner with you every day.

Leaving School

At the end of the school day, your class teacher will dismiss you. This will be earlier than our normal time and this is so that we can make sure that not all the pupils are leaving at the same time.
